**Possible Introduction of Committee Measures**

**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- SB 97  
Directs certain health professional regulatory boards to adopt rules by January 1, 2014, requiring licensees to document participation in continuing education opportunities relating to cultural competency approved by Oregon Health Authority.
- SB 439  
Clarifies that statutes regulating physical therapy apply to person who uses word or title to induce belief that person is practicing physical therapy.
- SB 514  
Expands eligibility for enrollment in Oregon Medical Insurance Pool to include parents of children who are unable to access health insurance coverage.
- SB 627  
Requires that one chiropractic physician serve on Health Services Commission.
