Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Work Session

- SB 88
Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt internal and external review procedures for denial of long term care insurance claims.
- SB 94
Authorizes Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt uniform standards for health care financial and administrative transactions of specified persons.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 233
Requires hospital that is affiliated with health system to use same procedures with respect to privileges that are used for physicians who are not affiliated with health system as are used for physicians who are affiliated with health system.
- SB 237
Extends whistleblower protection for hospital nursing staff to additional hospital staff.
- SB 238
Limits patient data that must be reported to Oregon Health Authority by providers of mental health and addiction services.
- SB 777 **
Modifies list of debilitating medical conditions for which medical marijuana is available and removes power of Oregon Health Authority to add other debilitating medical conditions to list.
