SB 94

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/21/2011 AGENDA: Authorizes Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt uniform standards for health care financial and administrative transactions of specified persons.

SB 101

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/21/2011 AGENDA: Authorizes payment for dental services under Family Health Insurance Assistance Program and under private health option of Health Care for All Oregon Children program.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 879

Directs Oregon Health Authority to convene work group to develop standards for administrative requirements for student placement in clinical training settings in Oregon and report to interim legislative committee on or before June 30, 2012.

SB 880

Requires independent audit of actuarial soundness of per capita rates determined by Oregon Health Authority for payment to prepaid managed care health services organizations if rates determined by Oregon Health Authority are not consistent with benchmark per capita rates determined by actuary retained by Health Services Commission.

SB 851

Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules prescribing rights of residents in residential care facilities, residential training facilities and residential training homes.

SB 852

Creates Task Force on Mental Health and Addiction Services for Underserved Populations.

**SB 854 \*\***

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Department of Human Services to provide nursing facility, institutional or home- or community-based services to needy individual who cannot live independently without risk of harm.

**SB 855**

Prescribes process for nominating individuals to serve as Long Term Care Ombudsman.
