SB 94

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/23/2011 AGENDA: Authorizes Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt uniform standards for health care financial and administrative transactions of specified persons.

SB 101

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/23/2011 AGENDA: Authorizes payment for dental services under Family Health Insurance Assistance Program and under private health option of Health Care for All Oregon Children program.

SB 97

Directs certain health professional regulatory boards to adopt rules by January 1, 2014, requiring licensees to document participation in continuing education opportunities relating to cultural competency approved by Oregon Health Authority.

SB 138

Allows Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine to assess costs of disciplinary proceedings and impose other disciplinary action on person subject to discipline.

SB 139

Modifies examination requirements for applicant for license to practice naturopathic medicine.

SB 454

Exempts certain practitioners from regulation by State Board of Massage Therapists.

SB 952

Permits supervising physician or supervising physician organization to apply to Oregon Medical Board for dispensing authority for physician assistant.
