#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- HB 2050  
Removes "permanent foster care" as option for out-of-home placement of ward in substitute care of Department of Human Services.
- HB 2048  
Authorizes Department of Human Services to maintain list of, instead of contracting with, lawyers and nonprofit legal services organizations to represent recipients of State Family Pre-SSI/SSDI program assistance in administrative hearings before Social Security Administration.
- HB 2051  
Provides that Department of Human Services is to determine qualification for and set amount of adoption payments through negotiations with prospective adoptive parents.
- HB 2052 A  
Expands definition of "child" for purposes of payments to subsidize adoption made by Department of Human Services.
- HB 2057  
Expands definition of "person with a disability" for persons who are served by Department of Human Services.
- HB 2058  
Authorizes Director of Human Services to impose civil penalty on unlicensed person providing adult foster care.
