HB 2111 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 05/09/2011 AGENDA: Modifies provisions relating to isolation and quarantine of persons with communicable disease and isolation of property contaminated with toxic substance.

HB 2059

Provides that moneys payable to ward in custody of Department of Human Services under settlement agreement or pursuant to judgment shall be paid into trust account or subaccount established by department or Oregon Health Authority for purpose of receiving such funds.

HB 2908 A

Prohibits person from knowingly performing pelvic examination on anesthetized or unconscious woman unless woman, or person authorized to make health care decisions for woman, has given informed consent to examination, court orders performance of examination for collection of evidence or examination is necessary for diagnostic purposes.

HB 3536 A

Directs Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to suspend, instead of terminate, medical assistance of medical assistance recipient who becomes inmate of local correctional facility for expected term of no more than 12 months.

HB 3230

Increases penalty for practicing dentistry without license to five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.
