HJM 4

Urges Congress to mandate limit on mental health care caseloads.

HJM 12 A

Urges resumption of White House Conference on Children and Youth.

HJM 13 A

Urges Congress to pass Social Work Reinvestment Act.

HB 2314 A

Allows person who is working as school social worker to be exempt from prohibition against person who is not regulated social worker using title, words or abbreviations indicating that person has authorization to practice regulated social work.

HB 3138 A

Authorizes State Board of Pharmacy to adopt rules allowing pharmacist to prescribe and administer vaccines to persons who are at least 11 years of age.

HB 2401 A

Encourages Area Health Education Center program to create family medicine residency network.

HB 2235 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to develop informational materials concerning maternal mental health for health care providers serving pregnant, postpartum and post-pregnancy loss patients.
