HB 2325 A**

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates Oregon Elder Abuse Task Force for purpose of studying and making legislative recommendations related to elder abuse.

HB 2111 B

Modifies provisions relating to isolation and quarantine of persons with communicable disease and isolation of property contaminated with toxic substance.

HB 2013

Abolishes Advisory Council for Electrologists and Permanent Color Technicians and Tattoo Artists and transfers duties of council to Oregon Health Licensing Agency.

HB 3311 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to explore ways to improve birth outcomes for women who face disproportionately greater risk of poor birth outcomes and to report to legislative committees in February 2012.
