POSSIBLE MEASURE INTRODUCTION

Public Hearing

SB 582

Prohibits public body from releasing information that identifies holder of or applicant for concealed handgun license.

SB 619

Requires that certain agreements for acquisition of real property by condemner contain provision relating to repurchase of property in event property is not used for public purpose.

SB 760

Modifies statutory provision authorizing release of inmates who successfully complete alternative incarceration program.

SB 761
