HB 2274 A

Permits certified peace officers from states adjoining Oregon to provide or attempt to provide law enforcement services within Oregon under certain conditions.

HB 2726 A

Modifies definition of "smoke shop" for purposes of Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act and directs Oregon Health Authority to establish certification system for smoke shops.

Work Session

HB 2662 A

Eliminates delayed operative date for provisions requiring specified state agencies and Psychiatric Security Review Board to provide Department of State Police with minimum information necessary to identify persons who are subject to certain court orders or about whom court has made certain findings for purpose of transmitting information to federal government.

HB 2678

Increases dishonored check fee from \$25 to \$35.

HB 2797 A

Describes "readily accessible" for purpose of prohibition on possessing readily accessible, concealed handgun within vehicle, when vehicle is snowmobile, motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle.

HB 3166 A

Establishes statutory limit of six years after date of decision for person to file request with Land Use Board of Appeals for review of land use decision or limited land use decision.
