HB 2241

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Expands definition of term "uniformed service" for purpose of employment protections for members of uniformed service to match federal definition.

HB 2403

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs certain state agencies to partner with Oregon Military Department to provide reintegration services for veterans.

HB 2404 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides credit against income taxes for providing mental health services to veterans.

HB 2638 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Oregon Coast Military Heritage Museum for costs of city fees and permits and bringing electrical power to museum site.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to establish toll-free telephone line to assist victims of military sexual trauma.

HB 2407 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to develop and implement program designed to encourage women who are veterans to take advantage of health care benefits provided by United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

HB 2578 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Director of Veterans' Affairs to establish third Oregon Veterans' Home in Roseburg.
