- HB 3205 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Creates Oregon Veterans' Business Enterprise Program.
- HB 3206 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Increases tax credit for health care providers who provide services under TRICARE contract.
- HB 3207
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires public employer to interview each veteran who applies for civil service position and meets minimum qualifications and special qualifications for position.

- HB 2403

- HB 2404 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Provides credit against income taxes for providing mental health services to veterans.
- HB 2919 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Transportation and Economic Development
Authorizes Oregon Business Development Department to make grants to small businesses from Building Opportunities for Oregon Small Business Today Account if business hires veteran as new full-time employee.
