Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 275

Requires board of education of community college district to develop standards for community college to implement to give credit for education and training obtained by person while serving in Armed Forces of United States.

SB 338 A

Establishes Task Force on Tuition Waivers for Veterans at Community Colleges in Oregon for purposes related to issuance of tuition waivers for veterans and their families at community college districts.

SB 809

Designates February 24 of each year as Edward Dickinson Baker Day in Oregon.

SJM 1 A

Urges United States Department of Veterans Affairs to place greater emphasis on transitional housing for homeless veterans.
