HB 3667

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies terminology relating to emergency medical services providers.

Work Session

HB 3649

Requires insurers, health care service contractors and multiple employer welfare arrangements that offer prescription eye drop coverage to also cover refills of prescriptions for eye drops under specified conditions.

HB 3657

Reduces certain nonresident fees related to commercial fishing.

HB 3112

Requires candidate or treasurer of political committee or petition committee who expects neither aggregate contributions nor aggregate expenditures to exceed \$5,000 to file certificate with Secretary of State.
