POSSIBLE MEASURE INTRODUCTION

Public Hearing

HB 3002

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides nonresidents who are licensed to carry concealed handgun in another state with protections provided to persons with Oregon concealed handgun license if other state used National Instant Criminal Background Check System prior to issuing person's handgun license.

HB 2506

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows person holding concealed handgun license to operate all-terrain vehicle while carrying loaded handgun.
