Chris,

It occurs to me that a simple resolution for small conservation projects relates is inherent in your observation about "applicability" dates.

If the amendment language states that precertifications are no longer required for projects of \$20,000 completed after the Section 1 date (April 15<sup>th</sup> or whatever date is selected) – that would work.

That offers much more clarity than a "director may" amendment that could take months to adopt – if then – and keeps people at work on projects that are beneficial.
