Measure Description:

Subjects person that advertises or purports to operate as appraisal management company to requirement to register with Department of Consumer and Business Services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on General Government and Consumer Protection to the House Committee on Rules. The bill requires persons who operate appraisal management companies to register with the Department of Consumer and Business Services. The agency does not anticipate a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but a fiscal impact will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
