Measure Description:

Directs certain state agencies to partner with Oregon Military Department to provide reintegration services for veterans.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon Health Authority, Housing and Community Services Department, Judicial Department, Department of Justice, Bureau of Labor and Industries, Oregon Military Department, Oregon University System (OUS), Oregon Department of Transportation, Department of Veterans' Affairs

Local Government Mandate:

This bill [does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: It is not clear from the provisions of this bill exactly what the named agencies are to do. The named agencies currently cooperate with the Oregon Military Department (OMD) and absent any clearer direction it is not possible to determine whether or not the agencies will be affected fiscally by the bill.

OMD currently has a reintegration program and this bill provides, potentially, additional resources. The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon Health Authority, Housing and Community Services Department, Judicial Department, Department of Justice, Bureau of Labor and Industries, Oregon Military Department, Oregon University System, Oregon Department of Transportation, and Department of Veterans' Affairs all indicate that the provisions of this bill, as written, would not have a fiscal impact.
