Requires home health agencies to complete a criminal records check on any individual paid by the home health agency to provide home health service.

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

House Bill 2650 requires home health agencies to complete a criminal records check on any individual paid by the home health agency to provide home health service.

This bill is anticipated to have no fiscal impact to OHA and DHS. Under current practice, both agencies complete criminal records checks on individuals paid by home health and in-home care agencies.
