Measure Description:

Repeals provision requiring that court be held in Pendleton, Hermiston, Milton-Freewater and Heppner in sixth judicial district.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, Public Defense Services Commission, Judicial Department

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
