Measure Description:

Requires annual report from each community college district and public institution of higher education on compliance with Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon University System

Summary of Expenditure Impact: See Analysis

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure requires reporting from community college districts and public institutions of higher education on compliance with the federal Jeanne Clery Act prior to July 1 of each calendar year. The report is required to note any areas of noncompliance and provide a plan and schedule for compliance to be remedied within one year of the report submission.

Oregon University System (OUS) and the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development (CCWD) are currently required to report to the federal government each October on campus security policy and crime statistics in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act.

The measure does not specify the time frame of the reporting requirements. OUS and CCWD assume that the measure's reporting requirements can be met using the prior calendar years October report to the federal government and that a new report would not be required. If a new report is required with different time frames, there could be a fiscal impact to community colleges and public institutions of higher education.
