Measure Description:

Prohibits assessment of system development charge or standby charge for water meter of higher capacity installed to accommodate fire sprinkler system in one or two family dwelling.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS)

Fiscal Light

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on General Government and Consumer Protection to the House Committee on Rules. The bill prohibits a greater assessment of system development charges or standby charges for water meters of higher capacity that are installed to accommodate a fire sprinkler system. The agency anticipates a potential fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Rules Committee.
