Measure Description:

Requires Department of Transportation to study importance of interstate bridges as part of transportation system.

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

HB 3158 requires the Department of Transportation to study the importance of interstate bridges to Oregon's transportation system. Based on experience with other similar studies, ODOT estimates that the required study could take 1-2 years, and that the contractual cost to conduct the study would be \$350,000 Other (Highway) Funds.
