Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Housing and Community Services Department to fund food programs partnering with Oregon Food Bank.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department

Local Government Mandate:

This bill [may] [does not] affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

HB 3179 allocates an unspecified amount of General Fund to the Housing and Community Services Department to fund food programs that primarily partner with the Oregon Food Bank. The workload impact to HCSD is minimal. The fiscal impact of the bill will depend on the amount of General Fund that is allocated.
