Increases amount Department of Education may expend from State School Fund to provide administration of and support for development of talented and gifted education.

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure increases the maximum amount the Department of Education may expend from the State School Fund to provide administration of and support for the development of talented and gifted education. The measure increases the maximum amount from \$350,000 to \$400,000.

The Department intends to use the additional funding to collaborate with school districts to improve talented and gifted education and increase monitoring of district programs for compliance with talented and gifted identification and instructional objectives.
