Measure Description:

Appropriates \$300,000 from the General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for purposes of operating a mobile training unit for emergency medical technicians.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

\$300,000 General Fund

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

House Bill 3580 appropriates \$300,000 from the General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) for the 2011-13 biennium for the purposes of operating a mobile training unit for emergency medical technicians. The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect on passage.

Passage of this bill will allow OHA to restore two Public Health Educator 2 positions that were abolished as part of the 2009-11 allotment reduction. The authority anticipates restoring these positions as full-time limited duration positions because the appropriation is only for the 2011-13 biennium

This bill requires budgetary action for the appropriation of the \$300,000 General Fund for the 2011-13 biennium.
