Measure Description:

Allows person to file request for reconsideration of claim under Ballot Measure 49 (2007) if person's date of acquisition of property was affected by conveyance of property and person reacquired property within 10 days after conveyance.

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure allows a person to file a request for reconsideration of a claim made under Ballot Measure 49 (2007) if the date of acquisition of the property was affected by conveyance of property and person reacquired property within 10 days after conveyance.

The Department of Land Conservation and Development assumes less than 10 reconsideration claims related to this measure. DLCD plans to allocate the anticipated workload for the rule-making, claim processing, and reconsiderations among existing positions. DLCD anticipates the total cost for claim reconsideration process, including associated Attorney General costs, to be \$37,313 General Fund for the 2011-13 biennium.
