### **Measure Description:**

Approves new fee adopted by Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists for criminal background checks.

#### **Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

# **Analysis:**

HB 5016 ratifies a fee of \$47.25 for criminal background checks that was approved by the Department of Administrative Services during the 2009-11 biennium. The bill increases license application fees from \$125 to \$172.25 and increases the registered intern fee from \$80 to \$127.25. These background checks will be conducted every 5 years, and licensees will only be charged the \$47.25 when the check is done. During the other years, licensees will pay a renewal fee of \$125 and interns will pay a renewal fee of \$80.

All of the fees in HB 5016 are passed through to the Oregon State Police to pay the cost of the background checks.
