Measure Description:

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution modifying amount of lottery income dedicated to funding parks and natural resources and authorized uses of lottery income dedicated to funding parks and natural resources.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Secretary of State, Statewide

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This measure does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The House Joint Resolution amends, upon approval by a vote of the people, the Constitution of the State of Oregon by adding provisions and amending sections of Article XV, section 4 related to the state lottery, modifying the distribution and use lottery income. The measure directs the Legislative Assembly to submit the amendment to a vote of the people in May of 2011 and to submit to a vote of the people the question of the continuation of certain provisions on November of 2034.

The fiscal impact is indeterminate. This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Energy, Environment and Water Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. Estimates on the costs to implement the provisions of the measure are still being prepared by the impacted agencies. A more complete fiscal analysis of the measure will be prepared as it is considered by the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
