### Measure Description:

Makes permanent temporary provisions relating to post-prison supervision for offenders sentenced to one year or less of incarceration. The bill matches the local parole and post-prison supervision inactive status with the practices of those under the supervision of the Parole Board.

### Government Unit(s) Affected:

Association of Oregon Counties (AOC), Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission

### Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill would remove the sunset to certain provisions governing the post-prison supervision of certain offenders continuing the practices in effect during 2009-11. If the bill does pass, it would result in savings for the Department of Corrections (Community Corrections payments to counties) in the 2011-13 biennium of approximately \$1.0 million.
