Measure Description:

Allows Oregon Racing Commission to establish license fees for certain persons by rule.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Racing Commission

Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

SB 149 would allow the Oregon Racing Commission to set license fees by rule with a maximum of \$30 for certain licensees instead of the fees which are currently set in statute.

For the 2011-13 biennium, the Oregon Racing Commission anticipates a revenue shortfall. With passage of this bill, the agency anticipates raising license fees from \$10 per year to \$20 per year. This fee increase would generate approximately \$46,000 in the second year of the 2011-2013 biennium
