

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: SB 250 - A

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Measure Description:

Allows school district to withdraw from education service district.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, School Districts, Education Service Districts (ESD's)

Summary of Expenditure Impact: See Analysis

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure allows school districts to withdraw from or to rejoin education service districts to be affirmed by two-thirds vote of the school board. The measure requires that a school district must submit a plan of withdraw or rejoin to the State Board of Education. The measure establishes a timeline for the State Board of Education review and approval or disapproval of the plan and effective dates of the decision to withdraw or rejoin. The measure requires education service districts to distribute to school district a prorated amount of state funding available to education services district.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Education and Workforce Development Committee to the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee.
