Measure Description:

Revises mission of higher education to meet numerical educational goals.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon University System (OUS), Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure declares that the mission of all education beyond high school is to meet specific numerical goals for the educational attainment of all adult Oregonians by 2025.

The measure has no fiscal impact. The measure is a policy statement of purpose for education of adult Oregonians beyond high school. The measure does not identify specific providers of education, which may include private non-governmental entities of education or training, and does not compel action to any state or local government entity. The measure does not specify how the percentages will be achieved or authenticated nor does the measure require adult Oregonians to undertake post-secondary education of any kind.
