Measure Description:

Exempts from disclosure under public records law audio recording of voice of caller to 9-1-1 emergency reporting system unless public interest requires disclosure.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Association of Oregon Counties, Cities, Oregon State Police (OSP), Emergency Management, Office of, Oregon Military Department

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill has a minimal fiscal impact to the agencies involved unless the number of requests to OSP for written transcripts is more than the agency expects. The bill also creates a civil penalty. This may result in some increased revenue, but it is not anticipated that this potential revenue increase will be other than minimal.
