Measure Description:

Authorizes court to impose probation with intensive supervision under certain circumstances when person convicted of certain drug or property crimes.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Judicial Department, Counties, Department of Corrections, Public Defense Services Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
