Measure Description:

Ratifies fees for the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill is a fee ratification bill for the private security program within the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST). The agency raised fees effective July 2010 and now must have those fees “ratified” by the Legislature under the SB 333 process. There is no General Fund associated with this program and it is supported almost entirely with fees.

The -1 amendment would reduce the fees and would result in \$228,670 less than at the DAS approved level. This would still provide the program sufficient resources to operate effectively for 2011-13 but may require the agency to propose fee increases earlier than anticipated in the future to keep pace with current program.
