## **NOTICE OF INDETERMINATE REVENUE IMPACT**

**Impact Explanation:** The measure would define the term “secure the greatest permanent value” as the act of ensuring that lands are managed primarily for timber production and revenue. It also requires the State Board of Forestry to modify all management plans developed by the State Forester of state forest lands to achieve the policy goals and directions reflected in the amendments by sections 1 and 2 of this measure. The outcome of those changes could impact revenues to counties, schools, and local taxing districts, but the size of this revenue change would depend on the changes to management implemented from any management plan changes.
