Measure Description:

Increases fee paid by persons convicted of driving while under the influence of intoxicants and persons entering into driving while under the influence of intoxicants diversion agreement to Director of Oregon Health Authority for deposit in Intoxicated Driver Program Fund.

Revenue Impact:

Passage of this bill is anticipated to generate an additional \$2,679,200 in other fund revenue for the 2011-13 biennium and \$3,782,400 for the 2013-15 biennium.

Impact Explanation:

This revenue will be dedicated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund (IDPF). The average number of DUII offenses is 24,680, however, approximately 18,912 (or 1,576 per month) of the offenses result in collection of a fee. Current law specifies that moneys in the IDPF may be used to pay for treatment and services for indigent individuals who enter diversion agreements including interpreter services and the ignition interlock program. The Judicial Department (OJD) will charge an estimated eight percent revenue management assessment on the revenue first collected.
