Measure Description:

Authorizes local governments to propose transit benefit districts covering area within quartermile radius of rail stations.

Revenue Impact: The Transit District will likely see a decrease in fare revenues.

Impact Explanation:

The measure allows for reduced fares for senior and disabled riders of public transit outside peak hours. This is contingent on the fact that the agency is receiving payments from Special Transportation Fund. This might be subsidy that is covered by higher fares for other riders or higher payroll taxes. This issue will further be examined as the bill moves to the revenue committee.
