**Measure Description:** Extends the sunset date on final certifications for the conservation and renewable energy portions of the Business Energy Tax Credit from July 1, 2012 to January 1, 2022. Extends the sunset date on preliminary certifications for the manufacturing portion of the Business Energy Tax Credit from January 1, 2014, to January 1, 2022.
