Modifies criteria for sitting winery in exclusive farm use zone.

Impact Explanation: The measure would allow wineries in mixed farm and forest use areas in addition to exclusive farm use areas. It would allow kitchen and dining facilities instead of a limited service restaurant and a tasting room. Insofar as the measure allows more activities at wineries, additional income and property tax will be collected. Additional wineries in areas of mixed farm and forest use could increase the value of properties and property tax collection revenues. The size of this impact is not known and depends on the number and size of new wineries established as part of this measure.
