Measure Description: Appropriates \$5,204.7 million from the General Fund to the State School Fund (SSF). Allocates \$371.9 million from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the SSF. Establishes \$0.3 million of Oregon Department of Education moneys for the SSF-related expenses. Makes available for the SSF, \$100 million from the Education Stability Fund. Declares an emergency and takes effect on July 1, 2011.
