WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Directs the Department of Transportation's Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division to record odometer readings for vehicles 10 years or older.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Odometer fraud on older cars
- Fiscal impact versus the economic benefit

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Specifies that odometer disclosure is voluntary.

BACKGROUND: In addition to allowing a person to submit an odometer certification form for a vehicle that is ten years old or older, House Bill 2042-A instructs the Department of Transportation to maintain odometer records in electronic format.
