WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) to adopt rule imposing license renewal surcharge of no more than \$25 on any hunter who fails to report harvest and effort for previous hunting season.

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Beginning in 2008, ODFW adopted rules requiring licensed hunters to provide a report of their hunting activities to the department. Under current law, there is no penalty in place for non-compliance. House Bill 2125 A would authorize ODFW to adopt a rule imposing a license renewal surcharge of no more than \$25 on hunters who fail to report.
