WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to cancel a person's driving privileges if the Department deems it necessary. Clarifies when a person may apply to restore driving privileges. Prohibits the Department from continuing or modifying a person's suspension. Requires a person to comply with future responsibility filings with the Department before the Department may restore their privileges.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Inconsistencies with implemented statutes
- Standard cleanup of ODOT-related statutes

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Clarifies that the court does not need to take further action to secure a driver license upon the conclusion of the hearing.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 2137-A makes several technical changes to statutes relating to the suspension and revocation of driving privileges to realign the Department's Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division administrative practice with statute.
