WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Names the bridge crossing Euchre Creek on U.S. Highway 101 near milepost 317 as the Wilbur C. Moore Bridge. Requires the Oregon Department of Transportation to create and post markers designating the name.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Wilbur C. Moore comes from a pioneer family that settled in Oregon. Highway 101 runs through the Moore property. House Bill 2185 honors the legacy of Mr. Moore by naming the bridge after him; the naming is not designated as a memorial.
