WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Exempts changes in points of diversion from removal/fill permit requirement if necessitated by change in location of surface water source and authorized by Water Resources Department.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Stream channel migration as a result of flooding
- Need to relocate diversion before irrigation season begins

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon's Removal-Fill Law (ORS 196.795-990) requires people who plan to remove or fill material in waters of the state to obtain a permit from the Department of State Lands. House Bill 2189 allows authorized water users to change the point of water diversion of surface waters without the need to obtain a removal-fill permit. The exemption would apply if there is a valid water right from the Water Resources Department and if changing the point of water diversion is necessary to adjust for movement of the waterway.
