WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires residential facilities to ensure that appropriate educational services are provided for residents under 21 years of age. Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Requirements for care facilities
- Cooperation between facilities and school districts
- Truancy issues for children in private residential care facilities

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Currently, skilled nursing facilities and other residential care programs are not required to provide educational services to residents under 21 years of age. HB 2282 requires the facilities to ensure that comprehensive and age-appropriate educational services are provided in compliance with state and federal laws and the individual education program of the student.
