WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows a tow truck operator to transport property for hire.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Tow trucks often go unused in the offseason

Allows tow operators more flexibility in business operations

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces original measure.

BACKGROUND: Tow truck drivers are currently not allowed to transport property. The holder of a towing business certificate will be required to submit a declaration of weight and register the vehicle as requiredunder ORS 803.410 (10). The towing vehicle must exceed 26,001 pounds and must still be primarily used for towing.
