**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to adopt rules establishing the minimum requirements, including continued training and education, for corrections officers to maintain certification.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Need for training

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Replaces the bill.

**BACKGROUND:** The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training is required to set the minimum standards for physical, emotional and intellectual and moral fitness for public safety officers including corrections officers, ORS 181.640.
